Tom Richards, an outfielder for the Carthage team that has already clinched its third successive championship, was the only repeater from the 1971 first team. Blunt moved up from the second team.

The squad was picked by a vote of coaches, with coaches not permitted to vote for their own players. Infielders and outfielders were not designated by positions. Coaches simply voted for the four infielders and three outfielders they thought were the best in the conference.

Carthage led the way with four first team selections. Augustana landed two berths and Elmhurst, Illinois Wesleyan, Millikin, North Park and Wheaton placed one each.
