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Pat Busch of league champ Illinois Wesleyan took runnerup honors to Colletti in the conference batting race with a .439 average. Last year's batting champ Stu Arnold of Millikin wound up third at .413, followed by Roger Scott of Carthage at .385 and Steve Danko of Millikin at .382.

Outfielder Rich Williams captured the league home run crown with four, while Illinois Wesleyan's James Shaw and Augustana's Paul Pobereyko shared the runs batted in title with 17 apiece.

Bob Unruh of Wheaton topped the circuit in doubles with six and shared the hits leadership with Colletti. Busch had the most triples with four, Arnold led in runs scored with 14 and Augustana's Jeff Underwood tied Illinois Wesleyan's Steve Mahany for the league base theft title with five.

Illinois Wesleyan walked off with team hitting honors with a lofty .329 team batting average, and North Park nailed team pitching laurels with a 2.68 earned run average.

Pitcher Eddie Moore of Illinois Wesleyan and first baseman Chuck Seeds of Carroll, both of whom were first team choices a year ago, were accorded honorable mention on the 1977 star squad, as were pitcher Kevin Lidbury and shortstop Paul Pobereyko, both of Augustana, and catcher Greg Lampe of Carthage.

The first team was made up of four infielders, three outfielders, four pitchers and a catcher. League champ Illinois Wesleyan and runnerup Elmhurst both had three players chosen, Carthage and Millikin both landed two berths and Carroll and North Park each had one.
