Chicago, IL (June 4) -- Elmhurst College won its fourth College Conference of Illinois and Wisconsin baseball championship in the last six seasons as the Bluejays coasted to a 14 and 2 record, a full three games ahead of second place Wheaton College.

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Illinois Wesleyan senior centerfielder James Shaw was selected the "Most Outstanding" player in the league by conference coaches, who also selected their annual all-conference team. Elmhurst College pitcher Tom Ludwig became the first player in conference all-star baseball history (the CCIW has selected an all-conference team since 1971) to be named all-league four times. Carthage senior thirdbaseman Scott Roe led the league in hitting with a .465 batting average and Millikin pitcher Brad Corban led the league in earned run average with a 1.06 mark, despite having no record in league play. There were no new conference records set among the season leaders in each statistical category.
