WHEATON -- Champion Wheaton took top offensive and defensive honors as final statistics were compiled for the 1956 CCI season which saw several team and individual records broken.

Wheaton's 383.1 offensive average topped Carroll, 314.4, Millikin, 311.3, and Illinois Wesleyan, 305.3. Wheaton was first in rushing, 294.1, while Lake Forest with a 121.7 passing average edged out North Central with 119.6. Wheaton's defense of 203.7 led Carroll's 211.3, though Millikin took first in rushing defense with a 101.0 average and Carroll first in passing defense with a 47.0 yield per game.

Runner-up Millikin's Joe Lambert of Decatur finished far ahead in ground gaining with 808 yards in 109 carries. Second was fullback Harvey Fladeland of Augustana with 615 yards in 112 carries, followed by Carroll's Joe Sydcow, 509, and Wheaton's Fred Brock, 504. Wheaton halfback Don Church of Redondo Beach, Calif., owned the top average-per-carry mark of 9.3 with 242 yards in 26 attempts.

Fullback Dick Camp of Wheaton copped the conference scoring crown with ten touchdowns for 60 points. Teammate Brock with 55 and Millikin's Lambert with 54 trailed.

North Central's Dave Evans replaced Millikin's Larry Kane as passing leader with 682 yards and five touchdowns. Runner-up Kane, junior from Carmi, put his CCI career passing yardage record further out of reach with 604 yards to make it 1823 in three seasons. Halfback Ed Bodnam of Elmhurst set two records in leading in the pass-receiving department. Bodnam caught 24 passes for 377 yards breaking the marks of 20 and 335 respectively.

Ed Chvatal of Lake Forest had the top punting average, 38.9, for the second year in a row, edging Carroll's Duke Radecke, 38.5 and Bodnam, 38.4. Bodnam punted 35 times to break another CCI mark of 32.

Wheaton, in rolling to its fourth straight CCI crown, smashed three team records. The Crusaders scored 261 points to break the old mark of 200 set by Wheaton in 1950 in five games. Harv Chrouser's men gained 2059 yards rushing to beat the previous record of 1647 made by Wheaton in 1950 and the Crusaders' 383.1 total offensive average-per-game topped the mark of 365.0 set by Millikin in 1954.

Workhorse Lambert's 808 yards gained rushing broke the record of 788 set in 1954 by Millikin's Frank Chizevsky. Fladeland set a new mark in rushes for one season with 112 carries, topping the Chizevsky-held record of 96, also broken by Lambert's 109.
