WHEATON TAKES SIXTH STRAIGHT CROWN

The Crusaders of Wheaton grabbed their sixth straight College Conference of Illinois title as they rolled over a surprising Illinois Wesleyan team (4-3) 37-14. North Central dumped favored Carroll for a tie for second place; each team won 5 and lost 2 league tilts. The Lake Forest Foresters whipped Millikin on the touchdown runs by Dennis Harmon. The Vikings of Augustana climbed out of the cellar at the expense of Elmhurst with 42-0 shutout.

Lee Stopoulos of Augustana took the CCI scoring crown with a total of 52 points.

Stopoulos was trailing the leaders by 12 markers going into the last game but he ran wild against the Bluejays for 22 points. Ken Hill, Carroll, Bill Barr and Dick Foushee, Wheaton, and John Turpin, North Central, collected 42 points during the season to tie for second.

Pioneer Ron Jensen completed 70 passes in 146 attempts good for 971 yards to lead all conference passers. Fellow teammate, Ken Hill was the top ground gainer with 663 yards in 101 rushes. Hill is only a freshman.

Tom Lewis of Lake Forest set a conference record for best average-punting. Lewis had a 44.8 average per punt to replace North Central's Don Long (43.6) as the league's best punter. The pass receiving leader was Millikin's Chuck Davelis who caught 25 tosses good for 413 yards. This set another CCI record.

Wheaton established new records for most yardage rushing, total offense, and best offense average. Carroll lead in passing offense. North Central led in team defense in both rushing and total offense.

NOTE: The annual fall meeting of the CCI will take place on Monday, November 17 at Illinois Wesleyan. The 1958 All-CCI teams will be picked at this time along with the meeting of the coaches of the various sports.
