Scotty Steagall, Millikin's sensational sharpshooter ran away with C.C.I. scoring honors for the 1949-1950 season. Steagall was second to Marv Johnson of Wheaton last year. Johnson tied with Bill Shouse of Illinois College for second but since Shouse missed two conference contests his per-game average was higher than the Crusader push-shot artist.

Wheaton and Illinois College placed three men in the first ten scorers and Millikin's Bud Ormand joined Steagall in this group.
