Official statistics released today show that Dick Hobbs, the big center from North Central College, led all scorers in College Conference of Illinois cage activity for 1964-65. Hobbs scored 265 points for a 22.0 point game average to edge second place Jerry Parks of Carthage by a two point per game average.

The lanky Parks scored 240 points in the 12-game schedule and averaged 20.0 points per game.

Both Hobbs and Parks are underclassmen and will be back next season.

Nine of the top 10 scorers in the league, infact, will be returning next season. Only one, Bill Mullen of Carroll, four scorer, is a graduating senior.

In addition to the top 10, four other players who played in half or less of the conference schedule and thus were not eligible for scoring honors, hit the hoops at a hot pace during their activity. Irie Grant of Carroll, defending CCI scorer, hit at an 18.0 per game average in six games while Millikin's Jack Sunderlik fired at a 26.8 pace during five games; Ron Greathouse of Carthage scored at a 17.0 clip in five games and Carroll's Tony Meade hit at a 14.8 average for six games.
