Three conference teams won two games and lost three in post-season play, bringing the CCIW's record against outside competition for the season to 45 victories and 30 losses.

Illinois Wesleyan won two games in the National Association of Intercollegiate Athletics Illinois playoffs, then was upset by Northern State of South Dakota, 88-76, in the first round of the national tourney at Kansas City.

Augustana, with Chuck Menzer idled by ineligibility and Mark Brooks and Wally Michna hampered by injuries, dropped a 63-59 decision to Central Michigan in a National Collegiate Athletic Association regional tournament game at Evansville, Ind.

Carthage was a 103-93 victim of Lakeland in the NAIA's Wisconsin playoffs.

The co-championship was the first since Wesleyan and Carthage shared the 1963-64 title. Wesleyan now has won or shared 11 championships and Augustana has been on top twice.
