Elmhurst was the team scoring leader with 1370 points, while Augustana established a new CCIW record by allowing only 878 points. Millikin led the league in field goals made with 592 and Illinois Wesleyan led in free throws made with 233. Augustana allowed the fewest field goals, 358, and Elmhurst's opponents sank the fewest charity tosses, 160. Millikin was the team rebound leader with 725 and Augustana gave up the fewest rebounds, 515.

Augustana wound up the best shooting team with a .498 field goal percentage and a .752 free throw percentage. The Vikings also had the largest winning margin, 18.5.

All teams except Augustana have completed their seasons. Millikin came from 17 down in the second half in the season finale against Illinois Wesleyan to take an 87-80 victory and throw the CCIW into a three-way tie for second. Parker led the scoring with 27 while Gravlin paced Wesleyan with 26.

Augustana will meet McKendree College for the National Association of Intercollegiate Athletics District 20 championship. The District winner plays in the national tournament in Kansas City, starting next Monday.
